RE: Costar Technologies and Subsidiaries position on *Section 889(a)(1)(A) of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2019 (NDAA)*

Pursuant to Section 889(a)(1)(A) of the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2019, Costar Technologies certifies that the products sold under this agreement do not use any video surveillance and telecommunications equipment produced by Hytera Communications Corporation, Hangzhou Hikvision Digital Technology Company, or Dahua Technology Company (or any subsidiary or affiliate of such entities), as a substantial or essential component of any system, or as critical technology as part of any system.

Section 889(f)(3)(B), as implemented through the Federal Acquisition Regulation, prohibits contractors from selling to the government video surveillance equipment produced specifically by Hytera Communications Corporation, Hangzhou Hikvision Digital Technology Company, or Dahua Technology Company (or any subsidiary or affiliate of such entities).” Accordingly, in some cases, Costar Technologies continues to offer surveillance equipment that incorporates Huawei (HiSilicon) Systems on a Chip (“SOC”). If your organization has concerns about surveillance equipment that incorporates Huawei (HiSilicon) SOCs, we can provide a list of Costar Technologies products that do not incorporate such components for your consideration.
